

# 2023 Scholarship Application

Santa Fe Federal Credit Union will award three \$1,000 scholarships for tuition and fees to full-time undergraduate students enrolled in an accredited college or university for the 2023-2024 academic year. The purpose of the scholarship is to recognize students who demonstrate academic achievement and community service, and who are interested in advancing their undergraduate education.

Scholarship applicants must meet the following qualifications for consideration:

1. Applicants MUST be a Santa Fe FCU or Borger FCU member in good standing with an active account. Children or relatives of members are not eligible unless they open their own account prior to the deadline.

2. Applicants must be graduating high school seniors or continuing undergraduate college students accepted or enrolled in an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or an accredited trade school program lasting at least six months.

3. All completed applications must be received by April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

All information given on this application is confidential and will only be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Non-winning applications will be shredded upon announcement of the scholarship recipient.

The Santa Fe FCU scholarship committee will judge each application based on context, expression and overall impact. The recipients will be notified in May.
